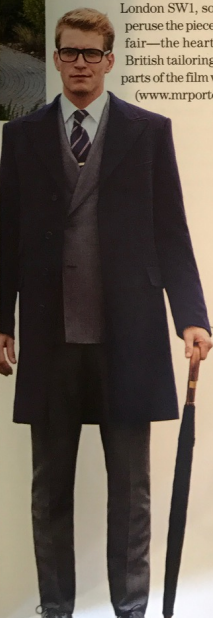


→ Dress to impress

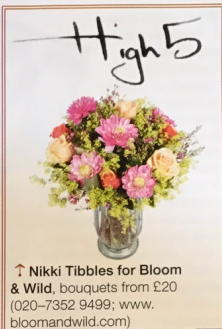
